ABOUT THE JOURNAL

Published by the Russian Academy of Sciences, the legendary journal *Voprosy istorii* ("Issues of History") has offered scholarly perspectives on events in Russia and the world since 1926. This landmark publication chronicles the remarkable epoch of the Soviet era, from its Marxist-Leninist origins through Stalin's Terrors, the Great Patriotic War, the Thaw and Perestroika, to Russia's transformation into modern post-Communist statehood.

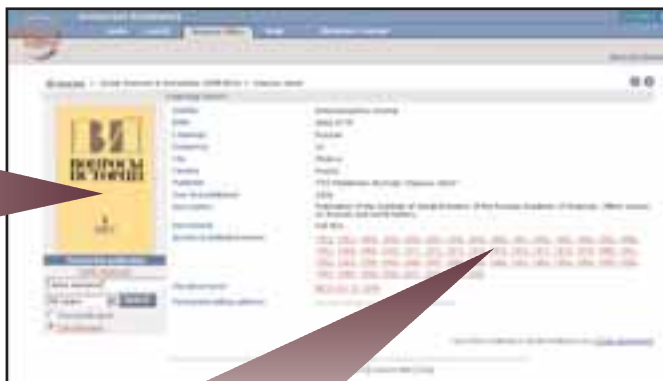
ABOUT THE DATABASE

For the first time, *Voprosy istorii* is now available online, in full text and full image. In cooperation with the publisher, East View Information Services began this mammoth project in early 2004. A pristine backrun was acquired and then

painstakingly digitized and accuracy-checked. The digital equivalent of 200,000 pages appearing in 950 consecutive issues was adapted for use in East View's familiar, powerful Universal Database™ format.
